Remember to:

- Take pictures & videos throughout the event

- Encourage attendees to submit their event pictures and stories to RedRemembrance.co.nz
- Submit an after-event synopsis to the NZDSOS team within 48 hours
- Update your donation page with the contributions received in-person at the event

Schedule:

All events are scheduled to start at 12:00 noon, 16 November 2024.

Here is a suggested flow for the day's event:

- Welcome all attendees to Red Remembrance with a reminder that this is a peaceful action, not a political protest
- Live musical presentation or a recorded song appropriate for the event
- A minute of silence
- The NZDSOS speech / address
- Live musical presentation or a recorded song appropriate for the event
- Invite the pre-selected vaccine injured to share their story
- Read updates from members of NZDSOS, including Guy Hatchard, Lynda Wharton, and Sue Gray
- Invite the crowd to share a story

Entirely Optional:

Creating a donation box for the day is a great way to accept spur-of-the-moment contributions, allowing attendees to chip in if so moved. HOWEVER, the event organiser is responsible for ensuring this box is always safe and funds will be deposited into The Vaccine Injury Sponsorship Fund within 24 hours.
